DAFI 91-212, Bird/Wildlife Aircraft Strike Hazard (BASH) Management Program (13 April 23)

1.3.9.2. The Chief/Director of Safety will designate the BASH Program Manager, in writing.

1.3.10.3. Due to the highly specialized nature of wildlife hazard management, staffing a dedicated wildlife hazard management professional is critical. The BASH Program Manager will maintain minimum qualifications in the Wildlife Biology Series (0486) or General Natural Resources and Biological Science Series (0401), under the United States Office of Personnel Management General Schedule Qualification Standards.



Will DAF BASH Program Mangers(PM) replace USDA? <u>No</u>

The intent of the DAF BASH Program manager position is to:

- provide continuity to an installation's BASH Program
- provide an AF wildlife damage control biologist to the Wing Commander's safety staff.

Currently, the BASH Program Manager is often a Flight Safety Officer, or a Flight Safety Non-commissioned Officer with no education and/or experience in wildlife damage control.



Will BASH PM be office employees or field employees?

BASH PM duties will primarily be office duties such WHA, permits, coordination with base entities for habitat management projects, funding advocate, wildlife strike investigations, etc. However, duties will be based on the need of the bases that fill the position. Some bases may require more field work of their BASH PM's.
